TO: Public/Private School Principals

- 1. This is to announce that the 2012 Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge Division Oral Competition (Secondary Level) will be held on February 17, 2012 (Friday), 7:30 AM at Towerville High School.
- 2. The overall objective of this activity is to contribute in improving the quality of mathematics education in the Philippines. Specifically it aims to:
 - a. awaken greater interest in Mathematics among high school students in both public and private schools;
 - b. encourage students to strive for excellence in Mathematics;
 - c. encourage mastery of basic mathematics skills;
 - d. discover mathematical talents among the students;
 - e. develop the values of hard work, perseverance, honesty, teamwork and sportsmanship; and
 - f. provide students with opportunities in leadership and cooperative undertaking.
- 3. Enclosure No. 1 contains the contest mechanics.
- 4. Enclosure No. 2 is the list of qualified schools for the Division Orals.
- 5. Enclosure No. 3 is the list of Merit Certificate Awardees.
- 6. Principals/OICs are encouraged to give their usual support to ensure the success of the said activity.
- 7. Wide dissemination of the content of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.

2012 Metrobank-MTAP-DepEd Math Challenge

"Moving Forward Through Excellence in Mathematics"

Mechanics of the Oral Competition

- 1. Each Oral Competition, whether team or individual, shall be written-oral contest.
- 2. Each team/individual will be provided with slips of paper for the answer to each question. Before the first question, they will write their team/individual identification on each slip.
- There shall be 20 questions: 10 fifteen-second questions worth (2) points each, 5 thirty second questions worth (3) points each and 5 one-minute questions worth (5) points each for a total of 60 points.
 - 3.1 The 15-second questions are to be answered mentally. There will be no writing anywhere, neither on paper, the table, etc. The team, of two, will work together as one to discuss their answer to the question. They may start discussing their solution after reading of the questions.
 - 3.2 For the 30-second questions, scratch paper will be provided for each team-contestant. Contestants may begin solving as soon as they wish.
 - 3.3 For 1-minute questions, a copy of the questions will be provided for each team/individual. Scratch paper will be provided.
- The quizmaster will read each question twice, after which he/she gives the GO signal. The timing starts when the quizmaster gives the GO signal.
- 5. Answer will be written on the official answer slips provided. As soon as the buzzer rings, everybody must stop writing.
- Proctors will collect the answer slips and give them back to the judges who assort them into two sets: those with correct answer and those with wrong answer.
- 7. One of the judges will announce the teams with the correct answer. The **scorers** record the points obtained by each team for each correct answer.
- 8. Answers must be given complete with units and to the required accuracy. However if the unit is already given in the way the question is asked, it need not be given in the answer.
- 9. The teams will be ranked according to their total score in the three parts to determine the winners.
- 10. In case of a tie among any of the teams vying for the first three (3) places, a set of 3 questions will be given to break the tie, one from each category of questions. If the tie is not broken after the three questions, "do or die" questions will be given.
- 11. The same Mechanics will be followed for the individual contest.
- 12. COMPLAINTS OR CLARIFICATIONS:
 - 12.1 Only the official contestants may raise a complaint or clarification.
 - 12.2 Complaints on a given question should be made before the next question is asked. This should be directed to the Chairman of the Board of Judges.
 - 12.3 Responsible for setting all questions, including protest, which may arise in the course of the competition
