

Schedule of PHIL-IRI Administration and Submission of Reports

- 1. The Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI) is one of the most useful classroom tools in assessing pupil's reading ability. The results can give the teachers information on the level of their pupils' performance in reading by actual observation.
- 2. In this light, principals and teachers are required to keep the Phil-IRI test with utmost confidentiality and thus test should not in any way be posted or exposed to pupils to maintain reliability and validity until the appropriate time of administration.
- In addition, principals and teachers are encouraged to utilize Phil-IRI pretest and post-test
 results for planning effective reading program to improve the reading instruction in their
 respective schools.
- 4. Furthermore, regular classes should be observed during the administration of Phil-IRI. Each Phil-IRI teacher-administrator is advised to strictly follow the mechanics and schedule of the administration to avoid delayed submission of reports to the Division Office.
- 5. This SY 2012-2013, each school will receive Phil-IRI materials for reproduction. Photocopying of Phil-IRI materials should be shouldered by the concerned schools.
- 6. Pretest and Post-test Phil-IRI results should be submitted in soft copy (MS Excel 2003 ver.) to Mr. Arthur F. Francisco, Division Coordinator ICT.
- 7. Enclosure No. 1 contains the schedule of Phil-IRI administration and submission of reports.
- 8. Immediate and wide dissemination of the contents of this memorandum is desired.
