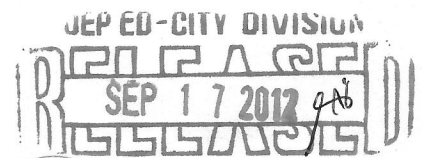

2nd REGIONAL ANNUAL STUDENTS' INDEPENDENT FILM (SINDI FILM)

Competition Mechanics

1. This is a search for best students' independent film and film makers, from the secondary schools which painstakingly devoted their time, energies and talents to contribute positive messages highlighting good Filipino Values and traits.
2. The search is open to all students who won in the division level competition in media arts from the schools offering Special Program in the Arts (SPA) Curriculum.
3. Each of the qualified films with a maximum running time of fifteen (15) minutes with no copyrighted music can have any of the following standard genres:
 - 3.1. Short Fiction
 - 3.2. Animation
 - 3.3. Documentary short subject
 - 3.4. Experimental
4. The students should submit their respective finished film in DVD format with the accomplished entry form before the deadline.

1st ORIGINAL PILIPINO MUSIC (OPM) SONG WRITING COMPETITION

1. This competition is open to all Special Program in the Arts (SPA) 4th year students.
2. School that are offering OPM in MAPEH IV are also encouraged to participate in the Division Level Competition.
3. The following criteria shall govern for choosing the winners.
 - 3.1. Lyrics and melody of the composition must be original, readily understandable and cohesive with minimum requirements of two (2) verses.
 - 3.2. Contrast between sections of the song must be distinguishable.
 - 3.3. Mood of the melody should match with the mood of the lyrics.
 - 3.4. The song should be effective for enjoyable and repeated listening.
 - 3.5. Performance time of the composition must not be more than three (3) minutes including introduction.
4. Only the Division winners shall compete in the Regional Level.
5. Awards will be given to the following winners:
 - 5.1. BEST COMPOSER
 - 5.2. BEST LYRICIST
 - 5.3. BEST PERFORMER
6. The contestant/s is/are required to perform two (2) songs consecutively, to wit:
 - 6.1. One Patriotic or folksong as warm-up song
 - 6.2. Composition – The contest piece.
7. The song Dr. Isabelita M. Borres, Mabuhay Ka! Shall be sung by all contestants in the community singing.
8. The contestants may use recorded minus one or live accompaniment.
9. Each division is entitled to submit one entry to be performed by the composer or may ask to perform it by other students or by group that shall not exceed seven (7) members.

REGIONAL MATH QUIZ

1. The Regional Math Quiz is a Math Competition intended to all grade levels in public elementary and secondary of Region III.
2. One (1) pupil per grade level from 18 divisions shall be the participants of this competition which is composed of six (6) pupils from elementary and four (4) students from secondary.
3. The test coverage for elementary level shall deal with Numbers and Number sense, Patterns and Algebra, Measurement, Geometry, Statistics & Probability and for Secondary Level Number and Number sense, Elementary, Intermediate, and Advanced Algebra, Geometry and Statistics.
