TO: All Private and Public Elementary and Secondary School Head,

CITY – WIDE JAMBORETTE

2. The City of San Jose del Monte Scouting Committee will be hosting CITY-WIDE JAMBORETTE on NOVEMBER 28 to December 1, 2012 at Puyat Compound , New Town Sapang Palay, City of San Jose del Monte, Bulacan.
3. The theme of the Jamborette is “ Be Prepared : Leadership for Life”.
4. Qualification for participants are follows:
 - a. Scouts
 - Must be a registered Boy/Senior Scouts
 - Physically fit as certified by a registered physician
 - Must have parent’s/guardian’s permit
 - b. Scouters
 - Must be currently registered
 - Physically fit as certified by a registered physician
5. All participants should bring their own tents, camping gear and food provision up to the end of the Jamborette . Transportation in going to and from the campsite should be the shouldered of the participating Scouts and Scouters.
6. Effort should be exerted vigorous, promote maximum participation of Scouts in the Jamborette.
