



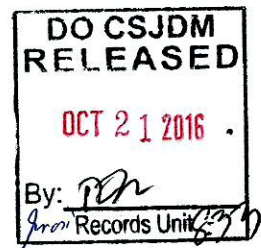



We are happy to inform you that the Girl Scouts of the Philippines, CENTRAL LUZON REGION will hold its Regional Training School (RTS) on October 25 -28, 2016 at the Central Luzon Region Program and Training Center, Brgy. Old Anupul, Bamban, Tarlac.

Hereunder are the courses to be offered and the details of these for your preparation:

A. DETAILS OF THE TRAINING EVENTS:

1. Training for Trainers:

Date : October 25 – 28
Participants: TL's who are at least Campcraft Certificate Holder.
Event Fee : P3, 700.00 which covers food, accommodation, Trainers Resource Folder (P500.00), materials and souvenirs.
Rationale : To increase the number of credentialed trainers and to replace inactive Trainers.
Arrival : 8:00 a.m. of October 25

2. Camp Management Course:

Date : October 25 – 28
Participants: TL's who have earned their Campcraft and must have taken the Campers Permit Course.
Event Fee : P3,200.00 which covers food, accommodation, training materials, and souvenirs.
Rationale : To realize the council commitment of one Campers License per year of the triennium.
Arrival : 8:00 a.m. of October 25

3. Camper's Permit Course:

Date : October 25 – 28
Participants: TL's who have taken the Leadership Course Permit Course.
Event Fee : P2,700.00 which covers food, accommodation, handouts, and souvenirs
Rationale : To equip participants with skills and knowledge necessary in the running and participating in camps.
Arrival : 8:00 a.m. of October 25

4. PL Camp Permit Certificate:

Date : October 25 – 27
Participants: Senior Patrol Leaders
Event Fee : P2,500.00 covers food, accommodation, handouts, and souvenirs
Rationale : To prepare the Patrol Leader to bring their Patrol members to camp by equipping them with skills.
Arrival : 8:00 a.m. of October 25

5. PL Camp Permit Testing:

Date : October 27 – 28, 2015
Participants: Members of the Patrol Leaders (at least 6 members)
Event Fee : P1,200.00 covers food, accommodation, handouts, and souvenirs
Rationale : In order for the Patrol Leader be tested and earn a Patrol Leaders Camp Permit Certificate.
Arrival : 8:00 a.m. of October 27

6. District Field Adviser Workshop:

Date : October 27-28
Participants : District Field Advisers
Event Fee : P1,500.00 which covers food, accommodation, training materials, and souvenirs.
Arrival : 8:00 a.m. of October 27
