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**NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON BEGINNING READING AND WRITING  
IN THE MOTHER TONGUE, FILIPINO AND ENGLISH OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION  
FOR THE CAREER ADVANCEMENT OF EDUCATORS (PACAE)**

The Philippine Association for the Career Advancement of Educators (PACAE) will conduct a series of its *National Seminar-Workshop on Beginning Reading and Writing in the Mother Tongue, Filipino and English* with the theme *Honing Teachers' Skills in Teaching Beginning Reading and Writing in the Mother Tongue, Filipino and English* at the **Romulo Hall, Teachers' Camp, Baguio City on October 9-11, 2015.**

The Seminar-Workshop aims to:

1. Understand the stages in teaching beginning reading and writing
2. Transfer their learners' beginning reading and writing skills in their mother tongue to Filipino to English
3. Use appropriate approaches to teach beginning reading and writing
4. Assess, evaluate and monitor their learners' progress in learning how to read write

The target participants are kindergarten/preschool, primary and day care teachers, English/Filipino teachers, preschool coordinators/supervisors, head teachers, principals, district/education supervisors, owners/administrators from both public and private schools and graduate and undergraduate students major in preschool/early childhood education and interested teachers.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.*
