

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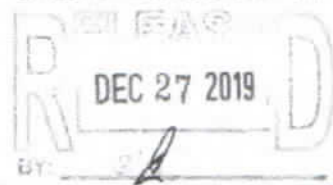

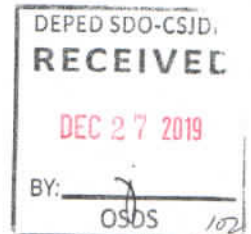

**CLAPSA REGIONAL TRAINING FOR SAFETY OFFICERS 1 (SO1)
(Basic Occupational Safety and Health [BOSH] Course)**

Theme of the Training: "Safe and Healthful Learning Environment: A Right for Schools' Stakeholders to Enjoy"

Rationale:

The training is in keeping and support with Republic Act No. 11058 (Occupational Safety and Health Standards Law) which stipulates among others that:

"The State shall protect every worker against injury, sickness or death through safe and healthful working conditions thereby assuring the conservation of valuable manpower resources and prevention of loss or damage to lives and properties consistent with national development goals, and with the State's commitment to the total development of every worker as a complete human being."

CLAPSA recognizes the importance of a conducive environment for all stakeholders of the schools, particularly school children, therefore, it is viewed necessary that the school environment be kept free from all hazardous elements that may impinge upon the optimum growth and development of the students and the full promotion of job/learning satisfaction, quality control and productivity. One positive step towards this end is for the schools to have a committee -in - charge of ensuring occupational safety and health in the workplace. This 8-hour training for SO1 is conceived as relevant and imperative.
