LEARNING RESOURCE DEVELOPERS' CONGRESS

1. This Office announces the first ever **Learning Resource Developers' Congress** on December 15, 2016 at Sapang Palay National High School (Secondary Level) and on December 16, 2016 at Bagong Buhay E Central School (Elementary Level).
2. The LRD Summit aims to:
 - a. Showcase the talent and ingenuity of students, parents, teachers and other school staff in developing various learning resources
 - b. Recognize outstanding LR developers and Improvised Learning Resource Centers (LRCs) and
 - c. Harness the different LRs developed in schools
3. For the purpose of having a common understanding, learning resources are any of print (text-based) or nonprint (non text-based), materials, devices, tools, equipment, and other media aligned with the K to 12 curriculum used as primary bases or as supplements to teaching and learning process (*Workshop in Managing K to 12 Curriculum Implementation in the Regions*).
4. Each school is encouraged to develop a variety of learning resources and to have those LRs displayed in their improvised Learning Resource Center during the congress.
5. Prizes await the winners in the following categories:
 - a. Best Improvised Learning Resource Centers
 - b. Best Strategic Intervention Materials
 - c. Best Supplementary Reading Materials
 - d. Best Powerpoint Presentation/Best Prezi Presentation
 - e. Best Digital Story
 - f. Best Charts/Posters
 - g. Best Improvised Manipulatives
 - h. Best Self Learning Kit for ALS students
 - i. Best LR for Differently Able Learners
 - j. Best Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) Modules
 - k. Best Audio Lesson
 - l. Best Lesson Exemplar/Lesson Plan/Daily Lesson Log (DLL)
 - m. Best Interactive Learning Resource
 - n. Outstanding Innovators of the Year
6. The mechanics in each of the above categories will be discussed during the training-workshop for LR Coordinators on December 1-3, 2016 at the Division Library Hub.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
