### 2018 Brigada Eskwela Jingle Making, Essay Writing, Poster Making and Recycling Contests

- 2. The contests aim to:
  - a. develop best practices in recycling;
  - b. express ideas creatively;
  - c. encourage schools to showcase talents of learners; and
  - attract more volunteers and partners for the schools' maintenance efforts before the opening of the school year.
- Contests are open to all learners of public elementary and secondary schools.
- The mechanics, criteria and entry form of the said competition are indicated in Enclosures No. 1 & 2.

#### MECHANICS AND CRITERIA OF THE JINGLE MAKING CONTEST

#### 1. Rules and Guidelines

#### A. Composition

- The jingle must be in Filipino language.
- It must be relevant to the theme.
- The time duration for the jingle must not be more than three (3) minutes.
- It must be an original composition made by the learners and may be through the guidance of a music teacher/coach.
- Any musical instrument can be used as accompaniment.

#### B. Participants

- The contest is open to all learners of public elementary and secondary schools.
- Composer can be either an individual or a group of learners.
- Only one entry per division may qualify for the Regional Level Competition

#### C. Entry Format and Requirement

- Each school is allowed to send one official entry.
- It shall be in an MP3 format with the title of the jingle as the file name.
- Entries must be sent in a USB flash disk or DVD/Optical Disc with the following requirements:
  - A duly accomplished Entry Form (Enclosure No.2)
  - Narrative report on the concept of the jingle.
  - Profile of composers and the music teacher/coach (which can be found in the Entry Form)
- The deadline for submission of entries shall be on or before March 26, 2018.
- The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable,

- The contest is open to all pupils/students of public elementary and secondary schools.
- Each school is advised to send one official entry.
- The theme of this year's competition is "Pagkakaisa para sa Handa, Ligtas at Matatag na Paaralan tungo sa Magandang Kinabukasan".
- The medium for poster making contest shall be oil pastel only. The required base paper to be used is an illustration board (size:1/4).
- All entries must be submitted to the SGOD Office on or before April 13, 2018.
- Decision of the Board of Judges is final.

#### MECHANICS AND CRITERIA OF THE ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

- 1. The contest is open to all pupils/students of public elementary and secondary schools.
- 2. Each school is advised to send one official entry.
- The theme of this year's competition is "Pagkakaisa para sa Handa, Ligtas at Matatag na Paaralan tungo sa Magandang Kinabukasan".
- The essay must be written in Filipino, type-written in an A4 bond paper, double spaced, one (1)
  inch margin on both sides, Font 12, Arial, minimum of 2-page and a maximum of 3-page work.
- Criteria are as follows:

Nilalaman at Orihinalidad	50%
Istilo at Lenguwahe	30%
Pagkakaayos ng Kaisipan	20%
Total	100%
