2nd DIVISION COMPETITION ON STORYBOOK WRITING

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 128, s.2018, this Office through the Learning Resource Management and Development Center (LRMDC) announces the conduct of the 2nd Division Competition on Storybook Writing.
2. The competition aims to:
 - a. select and award the best storybook originally developed by teachers for the K to 3 grade levels;
 - b. recognize the skills and competencies of teachers in writing and illustrating stories for children; and
 - c. collect storybooks for uploading on the Learning Resources Portal, and for printing and delivery nationwide.
3. The competition is open to all public elementary and secondary school teachers with permanent status, including the Alternative Learning System (ALS) mobile teachers.
4. All entries must be original. Any entry found to have been copied or plagiarized shall be automatically disqualified. In cases where such was only proven after the awarding, the winning entry and all its prizes and recognition shall be revoked and the award list shall be adjusted.
5. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.
6. The guidelines and the mechanics of the competition is provided in DepEd Memorandum No. 125, s. 2018.
7. Five (5) best storybooks in full package (story, illustrations & layout) per grade level will be chosen for submission to DepEd RO3.
8. Submission of storybooks to this Office is on October 3, 2018, Attention: Maria Eleonor B. del Rosario, PDO II / LRM Coordinator.
9. The winners will be announced through a separate memorandum and will be given certificates of recognition in the Division Awarding Ceremony which will be conducted during the Management Committee Meeting (MANCOM) on November 2018 at the Division Library Hub.
10. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
