- The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learning Delivery-Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID), celebrates the 2019 National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation (NDPR) Week with the theme Lokal na Pamahalaan: Kabalikat sa Pagtupad ng Karapatan ng mga Taong May Kapansanan from July 17 to 23, 2019. This is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation (PP) No. 1870, s. 1979. All Special Education (SPED) centers, and public and private schools with SPED programs are encouraged to undertake activities relevant to the theme of this year's celebration. However, all activities to be undertaken should not disrupt classes nor compromise their supervision pursuant to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith.
- Relative to the celebration of the NDPR Week, all SPED centers and schools with SPED programs must accomplish the AFR Form and submit it to the BLD-SID.
