Addendum to Division Memorandum no. 5 s.2014: Third Batch of Reading Recovery Teachers' Intensive Course

- This Office hereby reiterates the importance of implementing Reading Recovery as early literacy intervention to address the pressing literacy problems among lowest achieving children in different classrooms at schools.
- Hence, each school head with the assigned Reading Recovery teachers at schools is tasked to utilize the results of the oral reading assessment as basis for prioritizing children who will undergo the standard Reading Recovery or Modified Reading Recovery procedures. Thus, each lowest achieving child deserves 30-minute daily, individualized teaching procedures until each becomes independent reader for a maximum of three months.
- The RR sessions for the select lowest achieving children in literacy shall begin on second week of June 2014 onwards.
- Enclosure no.1 contains the schedule of Batches One, Two, and Three Teachers' ISSs.
- Immediate and wide dissemination of the contents of this memorandum is enjoined.
