## RECLASSIFICATION OF MASTER TEACHER I ITEMS TO MASTER TEACHER II POSITIONS

- This City Division announces the reclassification of Master Teacher 1 items to Master Teacher 11 positions. The number of Master Teacher 1 items to be reclassified will depend on the current needs of both the West and East Districts and the number of teachers who shall meet the required number of points.
- 2. Teachers who have held Master Teacher I position for at least one year and who will earn at least 30 points after the evaluation of documents are qualified for the reclassification of his/her own item.
- 3. Interested Master Teacher 1 shall undergo the ranking process and shall submit photocopy of the following document as requirements in the reclassification of items:
  - h. Certificate of District/Division Demo Teaching
  - i. CSC Form 212
  - j. Appointment paper (as Master Teacher I)
  - k. Transcript of Records(at least 24 Master's Degree units)
  - I. PAST (for the last 3 Rating Periods)
  - m. Certificates of relevant trainings and seminars
  - n. Certificates justifying the Outstanding Accomplishments within the last 5 years as subject coordinator or grade chairman, chairman of special committee, headed educational research, coordinator of community project or activity or program, managed or organized as in-service activity, authorship, curriculum instructional materials, effective teaching strategy, simplification of work and income generating project.
- 4. Schools are requested to pre-evaluate documents of candidates on or before June 20, 2014 and submit to the Division Office the Rank List together with folders on or before July 01, 2014.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
