



150th BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF APOLINARIO MABINI

1. In accordance with the commemoration of 150th Birth Anniversary of Apolinario Mabini y Maranan on July 23, 2014 with the theme : "Mabini : Talino at Paninindigan", all public and private schools are encouraged to carry out activities which will reawaken the Filipino people specially the youth of their responsibility and patriotic commitment and will give the students a chance to fully recognize the value of Apolinario Mabini as a political adviser of the Philippine Revolution and the First Philippine Republic and also the First Secretary of Foreign Affairs.
2. All schools are encouraged to conduct the following activities :
 - Sabayang Pagbigkas ng Dekalogo ni Apolinario Mabini during their flag raising on July 23, 2014 .
 - School -based/Classroom -based contests, lectures and other activities which will focus on the life , heroism and ideals of Apolinario Mabini.
3. Division contest will be conducted also on July 23, 2014 (8:00- 11:00 AM, Elementary, 1:00- 5:00 PM ,High School) at the Division Library Hub .
Elementary contestants are cluster winners while secondary contestants are school winners.
 - a. Essay Writing Contest
 - b. Poster Making Contest
 - c. Jingle writing and Singing Contest

5. Narrative report of school -based activities should be submitted to the division office.

5. *Pagpumilitan mo ang ikagiginhawa na iyong bayan bago ang kaginhawaan mong sarili.*

7. *Huwag mong kilalanin sa iyong bayan ang kapangyarihan nino mang tao na di mo pili at na iyon na kababayan.*

9. *Ibigin mo ang kapwa ng gaya ng pag-ibig mo sa sarili.*
10. *Laging titignan mo ang kababayan ng higit na kamali sa mong bayan.*

DIVISION ON – THE SPOT POSTER MAKING CONTEST

1. The contest is open to all elementary and high school students from the public schools.
2. Only one (1) contestant per school (HS) and one cluster winner (ES) shall participate in the contest.
3. The poster should revolve around the theme which will be announced by the contest administrator during the contest proper.
4. The contestant shall bring their own materials, illustration board of 20" x 30" and pastel color shall be used. Borrowing of materials from other contestants shall not be allowed.
5. The allotted time for the contest is two (2) hours after which all entries shall be submitted to the contest administrator.
6. Each poster shall be identified by a number that corresponds to the number and identity of the contestant for the judging process.
7. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

• Originality and creativity	40 %
• Relevance to the theme	40 %
• Over – all impact	<u>20 %</u>
Total	100 %

DIVISION ON – THE – SPOT JINGLE WRITING AND SINGING CONTEST

Contestants

- The contests are open to all elementary and high school students from the public schools.
- Only one (1) contestant per school (HS) and one cluster winner (ES) shall participate in the contest.
- 3 – 5 lines only (2-3 sentences).
- Topic or theme will be given on the spot during the writing contest.
- Filipino or English languages will be used as the medium.
- Freestyle of delivery / presentation is recommended.

DIVISION ON – THE – SPOT ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

1. The Essay Writing Contest/Paggawa ng Sanaysay is open to all elementary and high school students from public schools . Only one (1) contestant per school(HS) and one cluster winner (ES) shall participate in the contest.
2. Essay Writing Contest/Paggawa ng Sanaysay will be conducted on – the – spot at the division contest level based on a given topic/theme to be announced by the contest administrator.
3. Essay must be written in Filipino Language and must contain 500 to 800 words legibly written in double space in an intermediate writing pad (long).
 - Every article, definite and infinite is considered one word.
 - No abbreviation is allowed, please spell out
 - Less or more 800 to 1000 words not qualified.
4. Decision of the judges is final and unappeasable.
5. Entries for the contest will be judged based on the following criteria.
