Certificates and accomplishment reports within the last five (5) years as subject coordinator or grade chairman/ chairman of special committee/ headed educational research/ coordinator of community project or activity or program/ managed or organized as in-service activity/ authorship/ demo-teaching/ curriculum instructional materials/ effective teaching strategy/ simplification of work/income generating project.
