




FIRST DIVISION OPEN COMPETITION IN JOURNALISM (DOC-J)

1. In its sustained effort to maintain its standing as the **Champion in the Individual Contests of the 2013 Regional Secondary Schools Press Conference**, this Office is pleased to announce the launching of the **First Division Open Competition in Journalism (DOC-J) on August 26 & 27, 2014 at First City Providential College.**
2. DOC-J is a joint mechanism project of the Division Association of Secondary School Paper Advisers (DASPA) and the Division Association of Campus Journalists (DACJ) to capacitate the campus journalists (CJs) and school paper advisers (SPAs) in preparation for the Division Secondary Schools Press Conference (DSSPC).
3. It specifically aims to:
 - a. provide training specifically designed to hone the journalistic skills of the CJs;
 - b. allow the CJs to compete in the contest categories in journalism that they themselves choose according to their talents and abilities;
 - c. develop the oral presentation skills of the SPAs and allow sharing of knowledge and skills between and among them; and
 - d. simulate the procedures in conducting the contests in the DSSPC, thus getting the CJs more prepared for it.
4. It is open to all CJs and SPAs who are members of DACJ and DASPA respectively. To be a member of such associations, applicants should sign up and pay the membership fee of **Thirty Pesos** (Php30.00) for CJs and **Fifty Pesos** (Php50.00) for SPAs.
5. There is no registration fee. All expenses relative to the conduct of this event shall be charged to DACJ and DASPA funds.
6. Two-hour lectures on the basics of news writing, feature writing, editorial writing, sports writing, science writing, photojournalism and editorial cartooning will first be conducted by the select trainers followed by a one hour open competition.
7. Participants are advised to bring own materials and equipment for the contests.
8. Ten winners per category per medium will be declared. Each winner will receive a certificate of recognition.
9. There will be separate sets of winners for the private schools and for the public schools.
10. Points earned by each school will be tallied to determine the top performing private and public schools.




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11. The results of DACJ have no bearing in the DSSPC. Win or lose, a CJ may still compete in the DSSPC.

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
