

Bridging the Gap: Strengthening Indigenous People's Education in the Region through Community Engagement: A Training Workshop for the Development of Division IPEd Framework

- 1. In line with the Department's thrust to develop and implement the Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd) Program in response to the rights of IP communities to have an education that is responsive to their context, respects their identities and promotes the value of their indigenous knowledge, skills and other aspects of their cultural heritage, the Curriculum and Learning Materials Division (CLMD) of the Region announces the conduct of "Bridging the Gap: Strengthening Indigenous People's Education In The Region Through Community Engagement: A Training Workshop for the Development of Division IPEd Framework" on September 24-26, 2014 at the Regional Education Learning Center, Pulungbulu, Angeles City.
- 2. The activity which coincides with the Indigenous Peoples Month Celebration aims to:
 - 2.1. update Region and Division staff of the IPEd Policy Framework and Programs;
 - 2.2. develop advocacy plans within the Divisions;
 - 2.3. provide technical assistance to Schools Division in implementing the IPEd program;
 - 2.4. present the Division IPEd framework for appraisal and critiquing
- 3.
