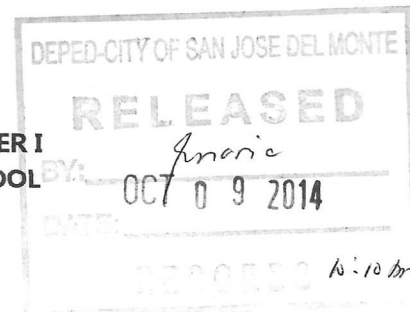

Per MEC Order No. 10 S. 1979 – ***“Implementing Rules and Regulations for the System of Career Progression for Public Schools Teachers”***, this City Schools Division will conduct an open ranking for Master Teacher I position for San Jose Del Monte National Trade School on October 15, 2014 (Wednesday), at 9:30 a.m. at San Jose del Monte National Trade School, City of San Jose del Monte, Bulacan.
2. Qualified candidates are Teachers I, II and III who have had five (5) years teaching experience with demo teaching in the district/ division and 18 M.A. units or its equivalent.
3. Candidates must submit a photocopy of the following documents on October 10, 2014 (Friday), for pre-evaluation and original copy on the day of the open ranking, labeled accordingly and with table of contents:
 - a. Appointment paper
 - b. Transcript of Records (Master’s Degree)
 - c. Performance Rating for the last three (3) rating periods
 - d. Certificates and accomplishment reports within the last five (5) years as subject coordinator or grade chairman/ chairman of special committee/ headed educational research/ coordinator of community project or activity or program/ managed or organized as in-service activity/ authorship/ demo-teaching/ curriculum instructional materials/ effective teaching strategy/ simplification of work/income generating project.
4. All documents must be arranged and labeled according to criteria/guidelines, DepEd Order No. 42 s. 2007.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is desired.
