

2016 DIVISION SECONDARY SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE (DSSPC)

1. Pursuant to Republic Act 7079 otherwise known as Campus Journalism Act of 1991, this Office announces the conduct of the 2016 Division Secondary Schools Press Conference (DSSPC) on September 8 and 9, 2016 at First City Providential College.
2. Embracing the theme 'Empowering student's press freedom', the activity aims to showcase the journalistic competence of student-journalists through healthy and friendly competitions and to best select the contestants for the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC).
3. Each public and private secondary school may field in a maximum of five (5) student-contestants per individual contest category per medium. A student-contestant may compete in two (2) contest categories but in the same medium either in English or Filipino).
4. Student-contestants in photojournalism are tasked to bring digital camera with a maximum of 16 megapixels while contestants in editorial cartooning should bring oslo paper and Mongol pencil no. 2.
5. Each student, trainer and coach-participant shall pay a registration fee of One hundred thirty (P130.00) pesos chargeable against school's canteen or campus journalism / MOOE funds to defray expenses for the judges' honoraria, customized medals, trophies, certificates, supplies, contest materials, training after the contest and other related expenses.
6. The top fifteen winners in all events per contest category per medium shall be recognized and the points they will gain will be included in the computation of the overall scores. Only the top three winners per category per medium will advance to the Regional Schools Press Conference come November 2016.
7. Pre-registration of the participants is scheduled on September 2, 2016 at 3:00 p.m c/o Allen Belisario, Jane Tangalin and Anne Cynthia Elizares, DASSPA Officers at the Reading Recovery Center, SJDWCS.
8. Enclosure no. 1 contains the schedule of activities and DSSPC committees.
9. Immediate and wide dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
