The Samahang Tagapagtaguyod ng Katutubong Sayaw ng Pilipinas (Philippine Folk Dance Society) Pampanga Chapter is persistent in its mission to promote folk dances in Pampanga. With this, the said organization, in partnership with the City Government of San Fernando through the City College of San Fernando, will be conducting the 2nd PFDS Pampanga Chapter Regional Folk Dance Workshop on July 22 – 24, 2016 at Robinson's Starmills, City of San Fernando, Pampanga.

Specifically, the workshop aims to:

- 1. Develop knowledge, skills, understanding and appreciation for folk and traditional dances as bridges of cultures and people of the Philippines;
- 2. To upgrade competencies in teaching traditional Philippine dances among teachers, dance trainers, choreographers, students and dance enthusiasts;
- 3. Provide teachers with resource materials on dance such as dance literatures, music CDs, videos, hand outs, etc.;
- 4. Provide a forum to discuss significant issues and concerns of folk dancers, dance teachers, trainers and choreographers;

The 3 – day workshop include learning of published dances, lecture demonstrations, forum, street dance, a culminating dance showcase by all the participants, folk dance competition and the general assembly of the members of the chapter.

A registration fee of Two Hundred Pesos (P 200) for teachers and professionals and One Hundred Pesos (P100) for the students shall be charged to cover workshop expenses including workshop materials, supplies, kits, and honoraria for speakers, resource persons, staff and other incidental expenses. Participants shall take care of their own transportation and meals. Registration will be from 9:00am to 10:00am.
