Step 5. Send the output to arthur.francisco@deped.gov.ph

- Initiatives done from March 17 to April 1 are likewise requested to be submitted to arthur.francisco@deped.gov.ph with the following guidelines:
 - a. Choose pictures in action and paste 2 to 3 pictures in a one-page document.
 - Caption the pictures indicating the activity, persons involved, date and name of school/office.
 - c. Save in MS Word format using the name of school/office as filename.
- Artworks and letters submitted to bit.ly/DepEdLetterofGratitudeandHope and covidletters@gmail.com are similarly requested to be submitted to arthur.francisco@deped.gov.ph.
- Should pictures involving minors be used, it must adhere to Data Privacy Act and with consent of their parents/guardians. The faces of the minor shall be blurred if the consent of the parent/guardian could not be obtained.
- Submissions that did not follow Item Nos. 4,5&6 will not be entertained. This is to prevent flooding
 of submission in various group chats/ other social media platforms and tagging wrong information
 to pictures.
