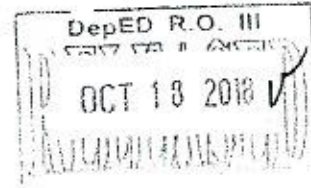



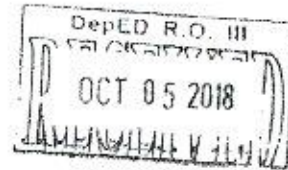

Greetings from BFAR R03!

The Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources, through its Fisheries Scholarship Program (FSP) will be conducting the Nationwide Recruitment Examinations for Fisheries Industry Leaders Grant (FILG) and Fisherfolk Children Educational Grant (FCEG) on 12th January 2019 (Saturday). The scholarship program is open to all applicants who have the following qualifications:

Fisheries Industry Leaders Grant (FILG)

1. Must be a natural-born Filipino citizen;
2. Any high school graduate or graduating student;
3. Not more than 25 years old at the time of the examination, who has not earned any units in college;
4. Who belongs to the TOP TEN of his/ her graduating class, duly certified by the school head/ principal;
5. For high school graduate applicants who completed their high school under the old curriculum, the general weighted average (GWA) shall not be lower than 80%;
6. For graduating students GWA of the last 3 immediate preceding semesters of his/her Senior High School in any Track shall not be lower than 80% or its equivalent;
7. Of good moral character as certified by the school head;
8. Parent(s)/guardian or the applicant must be physically residing in the municipality of the region for at least six (6) months, where the slot of the scholarship program is allotted.

Fisherfolk Children Educational Grant (FCEG)

1. Must be a natural-born Filipino citizen;
2. Any Senior high school graduate or graduating student whose parent(s) or guardian is a Registered Fisherfolk (Fish-R/Mangingisdang Juan);
3. Not more than 25 years old at the time of the examination, who has not earned any units in college;
4. For high school graduate applicants who completed their high school under the old curriculum, the general weighted average (GWA) shall not be lower than 80%;
5. For Senior students under K12 curriculum, graduating students GWA of the last 3 immediate preceding semesters of his Senior High School in any Track shall not be lower than 80% or its equivalent;
6. Of good moral character as certified by the school head/principal;
7. Parent(s)/guardian or the applicant must be physically residing in the municipality of the Region for at least six (6) months, where the slot of the scholarship program is allotted;
8. Parent(s)/guardian must be registered municipal fisherfolk duly certified by the Municipal Agricultural Officer (MAO) or the BFAR regional office in his/her area.

Scholars shall be entitled to the following:

1. A full scholarship grant for college studies leading to the degree of Bachelor of Science in Fisheries;
2. Free matriculation and other school fees except for dormitory fee;
3. Monthly stipend worth Php 4,000.00 /month
4. Semestral book allowance worth Php 2,000.00
5. OJT Support worth Php. 3,000.00
6. Research/ Thesis/ Special Problem support worth Php 7,000.00
7. Graduation Support worth Php 1,500.00

Enclosed is the copy of the application forms for distribution and filing of interested applicants. The deadline for submission of application is on 13th **November 2018**. Said application should be submitted to Mr. Stephen Arlo Lapid or Mr. Nico Wamil, the Regional Fisheries Scholarship Coordinator and the Alternate of this Office.
