DIVISION ACTIVITIES IN CELEBRATION OF THE 2017 TANGLAWAN FESTIVAL

1. This is to announce and enjoin support and participation in the Division activities in connection with the 2017 Tanglawan Festival.
2. On September 8, 2017, the attempt to set the **Guinness World's Largest Lantern Parade** will commence at Colinas Verdes Subdivision and end at Altarazza. The 17,000 identified learners and teachers from secondary schools and 420 steward-teachers from elementary schools are expected to be at the starting point at 1:00 p.m. with their own lanterns as well as water jugs, rain coat/umbrella. They will be served afternoon snacks and dinner by the City Government. As this is a milestone in the history of the City, Division personnel, school heads, and all DepEd CSJDM stakeholders are invited to witness the parade and give support to the activity.
3. Transportation of parade participants and stewards from their respective schools to the Colinas Verdes Subdivision shall be charged against local school funds subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations. After the parade, shuttle vehicles which transported the participants to the starting point will again bring passengers from Altarazza to the school's barangay
4. Lantern parade student-participants are to wear their respective school uniforms while teacher-participants shall be in white shirt for proper identification. Stewards will be in their Brigada shirts.
5. On September 9, 2017, 6:00 a.m., the **Alay Lakad** will commence at the Productivity Center Sapang Palay Proper and Sto. Rosario Sapang Palay College and converge at the San Jose Del Monte National Trade School. School Heads shall send teacher representatives to join the Alay Lakad.
