1. The City Tourism Office envisions the City of San Jose del Monte to be a highly developed premier City that is dynamic and progressive with pro-active and sustainable tourism that could contribute to the growth of the country's tourism industry.
2. In line with the Department of Education's public private partnership program, the City Schools Division of San Jose Del Monte expresses support to the City Tourism's priority project known as "**Bayan Ko Kilalanin Ko**" to promote local tourism awareness.
3. One thousand three hundred (**1,300**) **public schools teachers** from our division are enjoined to take part in the said project through travelling around the city and experiencing the customs and traditions of our native "**Dumagats**" and by exploring our various tourism sites.
4. Expenses relative to the conduct of this tour such as meals, snacks and transportation shall be charged to the City Tourism Office except for the Eco fee of forty pesos (P 40.00) each participant to be used by the Task Force Kalikasan for maintenance purposes.
5. There are ten (10) batches of tours stated in Enclosure No. 1. and each batch consists of minimum of 125 teacher-participants.
6. The Tour will start on **Saturday, March 18, 2017** and ends on December 9, 2017. Refer to Enclosure no. 2 for details about the journey.
7. Names of participants to take part in this project must be filled in and submitted to the SGOD Office on or before **Wednesdays** before the actual date of tour. (see Enclosure No. 3)
