


2015 DIVISION ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

- 1. This Office announces the conduct of the 2015 Division Elementary Schools Press Conference (DESPC) on August 27 and 28, 2015 at Tungkong Mangga Elementary School (TMES) from 7:30 A.M.-6:00 P.M.
- 2. The activity aims to best select the contestants for the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) and to enhance the journalistic skills of campus journalists and teacher-coaches through healthy and friendly competitions.
- 3. Each public and private elementary school may field in a maximum of five (5) pupilcontestants per individual contest category per medium. A pupil-contestant may compete in two (2) contest categories but in the same medium either in English or Filipino.
- 4. Pupil-contestants in photojournalism should bring any digital camera with a maximum of 16 megapixels while contestants in editorial cartooning should bring oslo paper and drawing pens.
- 5. Each pupil, trainer and coach-participant shall pay a registration fee of One hundred (P100.00) pesos chargeable against school's canteen or campus journalism funds . The registration fee shall be used to cover the honoraria of judges, food, contingency and other related expenses incurred in the conduct of the activity.
- 6. The top fifteen winners in all events per contest category per medium shall be recognized and the points they will gain will be included in the computation of the overall scores. Only the top three winners per category per medium will advance to the Regional Schools Press Conference come November 2015.
- 7. Pre-registration of the participants is scheduled on August 21, 2015 from 1:00 P.M onwards c/o Marife Baltazar, DASSPA treasurer at the Reading Recovery Center, SJDMWCS.
- 8. Enclosure no. 1 contains the schedule of activities and DESPC committees.
- 9. Immediate and wide dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
