





RANKING FOR RECLASSIFICATION OF SECONDARY SCHOOL DEPARTMENT HEAD POSITIONS

- The City Schools Division will conduct a ranking of Secondary School Department Heads for secondary schools with seven (7) or more teachers in the department/subject area but has no existing Head Teacher position. The ranking will be held on Wednesday, August 5, 2015, 9:00a.m. at the Division Office Conference Room, San Ignacio St., Poblacion, City of San Jose del Monte.
- 2. Applicant must have a Bachelor's Degree in Secondary Education or Bachelor's Degree with 18 Professional Education Units with appropriate field of specialization, Teacher for three (3) years, and 24 hours of relevant training.
- 3. The duplicate copy of the following requirements must be submitted on Monday, August 3, 2015 not later than 5:00pm. and the original copy during the ranking proper:
 - a. Recommendation from the Principal
 - b. Letter of Intent
 - c. CSC Form 212
 - d. Transcript of Records
 - e. Eligibility/License
 - f. Service Records
 - g. Performance Rating for the last three (3) years
 - h. General Class/ School Program
 - i. Individual Class Program of the teachers under the subject area recommended
 - j. Certificate of Trainings and Outstanding Accomplishment in the school
 - k. Other Outstanding Accomplishments (awards, innovations, research, resource speakership in trainings, authorship)
- Bases for appreciation of documents are DepEd Orders No. 39 and 42 series of 2007, and Regional Memorandum No. 1, series of 2013. Computation of points is enclosed for guidance.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is desired.

Computation of Points (Excerpts from DepEd Order No. 42, s. 2007)

A. Performance Rating (30 points)

The performance rating of the appointee for the last three (3) rating periods, prior to screening should be at least Very Satisfactory. The average of the numerical ratings shall be given points as follows:

Numerical Rating	Points	
9.4-10	- 3	0
8.7-9.3	- 2	.5
8.0-8.6	- 2	0
7.3-7.9	- 1	5
6.6-7.2	- 1	0

B. Experience (10 points)

Experience must be relevant to the duties and functions of the position to be filled, with every year given a point but not to exceed ten (10) points. Every month in excess of one year shall be given a point.
