DIVISION SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING IMPLEMENTERS OF GULAYAN SA PAARALAN PROGRAM 2015

Public Schools District Supervisors To: Public Elementary/Secondary School Heads

- 1. In line with the National Government Programs for food security and economic stability and as a support to strengthen vegetable gardens in schools, the 2015 Division Search for Outstanding Implementers of Gulayan sa Paaralan Program will be conducted from September to December 2015.
- 2. The search aims to promote vegetable production in public elementary and secondary schools to maintain school gardens as ready food basket/source of vegetables in sustaining supplementary feeding, serve as laboratory for learners, improve learners' nutrition and showcase small-scale food production models.
- 3. The search is open to all public elementary and secondary schools.
- 4. The Division Evaluation Committee shall select the following:
 - 4.1 Top three School Implementers of Gulayan sa Paaralan (School/Backyard Gardening) -1st place, 2nd place and 3rd place.
 - 4.2 Top three School Implementers of Gulayan sa Paaralan (Urban/Containerized Gardening- 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place.
- 5. The schedule of Division Evaluation and Inspection for both elementary and secondary schools will be on October 26-30, 2015 (first round) and December 7-11, 2015 (second round).
- The Board of Judges shall consist of the following:
 - 6.1 Education Program Supervisors
 - 6.2 One representative from the elementary group
 - 6.3 One representative from the secondary group
 - 6.4 One representative from the SGOD
- 7. For guidance, refer to attached criteria for evaluation.
- 8. Prizes and other expenses incurred to the conduct of this search shall be charged against Special Education Funds (SEF).
- 9. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.


