

## **IMPLEMENTING DIVISION BRIGADA ESKWELA 2015**

- 1. Pursuant to **DepEd Memorandum No. 41, s. 2015** re: Implementing Brigada Eskwela 2015 also known as the National Schools Maintenance Week from **May 18 to 23, 2015** with the theme *Tayo Para sa Kalinisan, Kaligtasan at Kahandaan ng Ating mga Paaralan,* this Office is pleased to announce the conduct of Brigada Eskwela 2015 in all the schools in the division.
- 2. On May 18, 2015- this City Division will hold the Brigada Eskwela Caravan which will start in San Jose del Monte West Central School at exactly 7 A.M. and will end in San Jose del Monte National Trade School where the Kick off Ceremony will be held.
- 3. School delegates to the caravan must be at least ten persons including the school head and PTA president and should bring tarpaulin, balloons, flaglets with sky blue and white colors. They should also wear the **prescribed Brigada Eskwela White Polo T-shirt** during the caravan.
- 4. School heads are expected to take the lead role in planning the activities geared on making their schools disaster- prepared, ecologically conscious, clean and conducive to learning and in ensuring the orderly and successful conduct of the weeklong BE activities.
- 5. The conduct of BE activities in all schools will be monitored by the assigned Division Office personnel.
- 6. Submission of BE Accomplishment Reports is on June 30, 2015.
- 7. Expenses relative to the conduct of BE Eskwela Caravan and Kick off shall be charged to SEF subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
