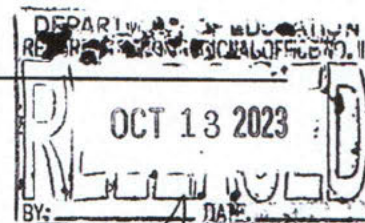

JUSTIFICATION

The Rapid Mathematics Assessment (RMA) is a vital tool designed for evaluating the foundational mathematical skills of learners in Grades 1 to 3. Its primary aim is to pinpoint any gaps in these essential skills. To achieve this objective, the RMA is administered during the first quarter of each school year. This timing serves several strategic purposes:

Early Intervention: Administering the RMA at the start of the school year enables early intervention. The primary rationale is to swiftly identify skill gaps, empowering educators to promptly address them. This early intervention is critical because it allows teachers to implement targeted support and instructional strategies, significantly influencing a learner's mathematical development throughout the school year.

Baseline Measurement: The first quarter assessment acts as a baseline measurement, offering a snapshot of learners' mathematical proficiency at the beginning of the academic year. This baseline helps teachers and school administrators track progress over time and assess the effectiveness of instructional strategies and curriculum adjustments.
